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From Mischievous to Curious

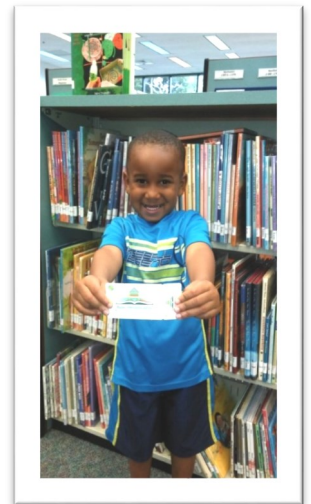
I am Debra H. Floyd, the great aunt of Aden Gordon and Jakii Washington (relative care giver of Jakii Washington).
